

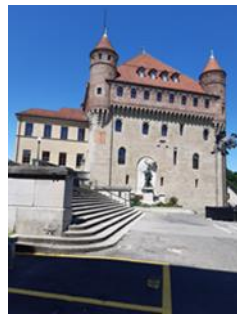


Guided city tour Lausanne in e-bike
